- 3) Food vendor propane tanks must be standard 20 lbs and certified by the New York Fire Department. Two tanks are permitted per vendor. Additional tanks must be stored off the pier. All vendors must follow applicable New York City Vending Laws.
- 4) The applicant agrees to indemnify and to hold harmless the Brooklyn Community Board #7 and their respective Directors, Officers, Employees and its Agents from all claims, suits, actions, loss, liabilities and damages, including, but not limited to attorneys' fees and cost arising out of or caused by the vendor's activities. The applicant further agrees to comply with all pertinent provisions of New York State Laws, Rules and Regulations.
